BOOK LAUNCH “I AM THE FUTURE”









Our 5th and 6th graders embarked on an exciting journey into the world of natural disasters by crafting and erupting their own volcanoes!


Through this interactive experiment, they discovered the science behind volcanic eruptions, from magma buildup to the powerful forces that shape our planet.

CREATIVITY WITH SNOW FLAKES!




STEAM CHALLENGE: DESIGNING SHELTERS FOR OUR FURRY FRIENDS!

LEARNING ABOUT THE SOLAR SYSTEM


