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VISIT TO THE METROPOLITAN MUSEUM



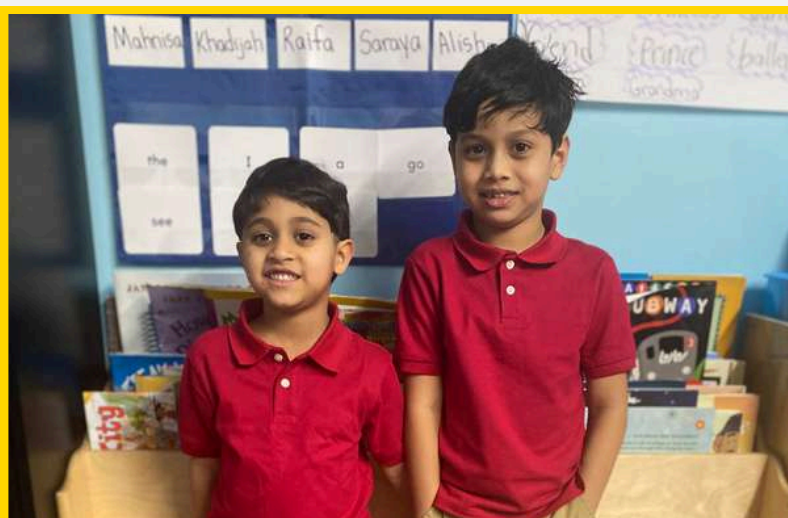

EXPLORING THE POWER OF NATURE!

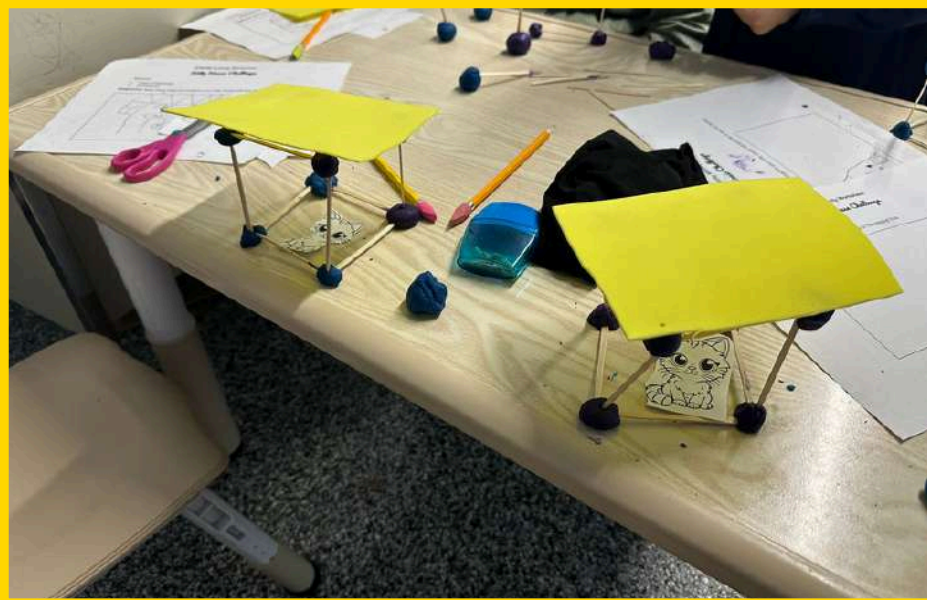
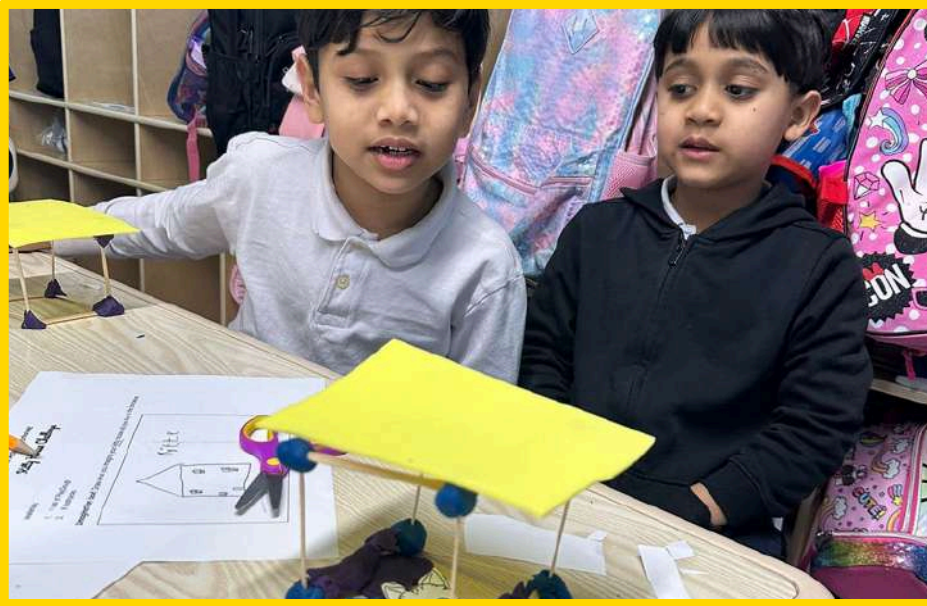

CREATIVITY WITH SNOW FLAKES!

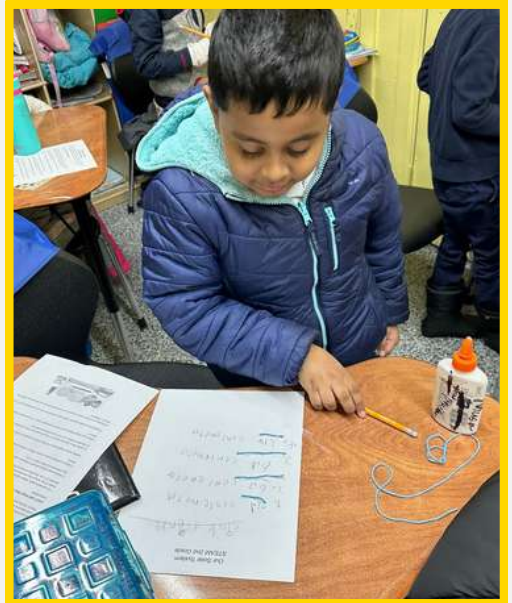

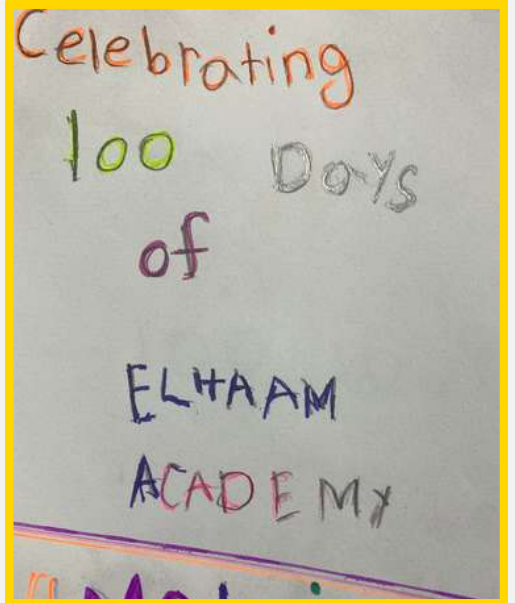
CRITICAL THINKING AND PROBLEM-SOLVING SKILLS
