





HOW CAN CLEAN WATER AND SANITATION CHANGE THE WORLD?




To me, industry means the work people do to make and sell things, like in a cookie or computer business. Innovation means creating or inventing new things


"Infrastructure means systems or structures that support a good business, and can help the community thrive. This goal can help society with healthy business practices."

HOW CAN LIFE ON LAND CHANGE THE WORLD?




