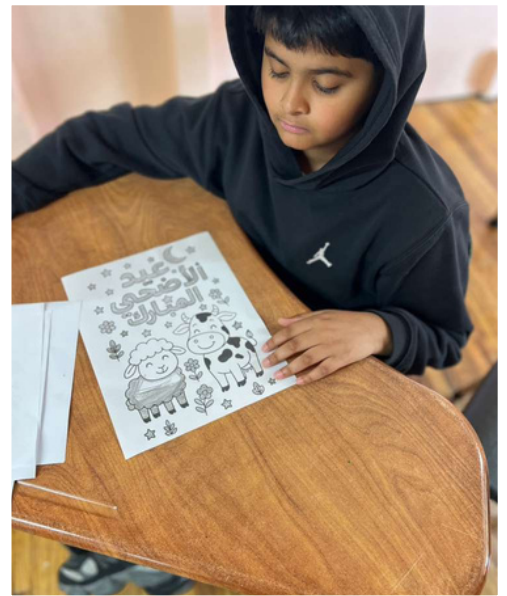
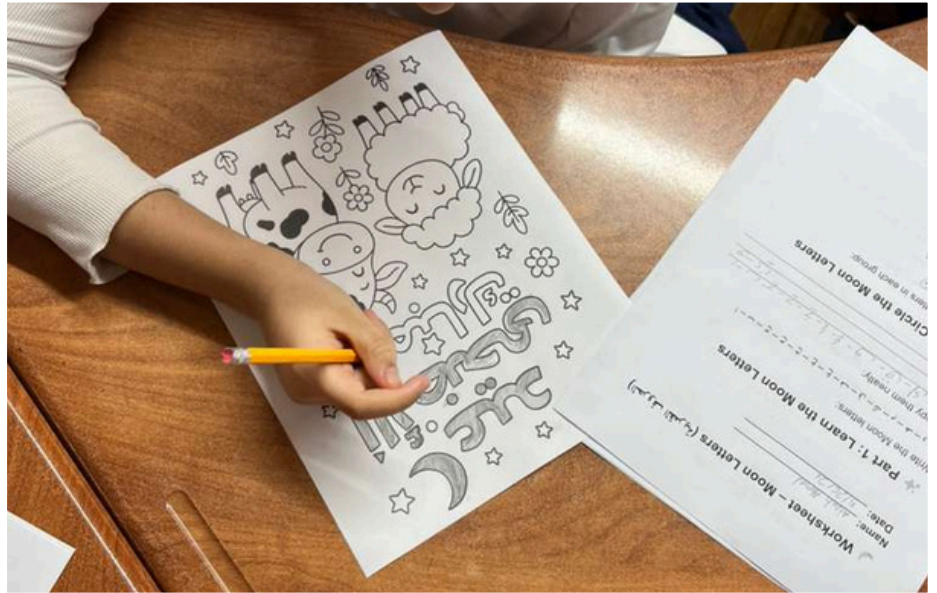




Eid Al Adha Story Time & Crafts

Khutbah at Elhaam Academy

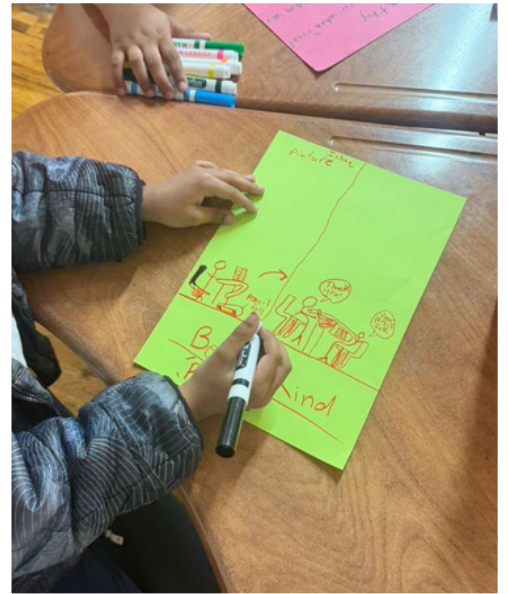
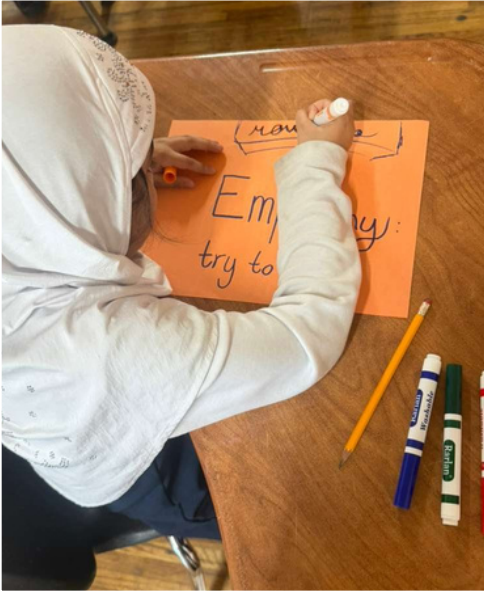
